Financial Aid Application Procedures

Timely and careful completion of each of the following steps will ensure that you are considered for all possible aid. Priority will be given to files completed by June 1.

If you haven't already done so, submit your **Application for Admission** to the Admissions Office.

Submit a **Nebraska Christian College Financial Aid Information Form** to the NCC Financial Aid Office. This MUST be filled out and returned to NCC as part of your eligibility for financial aid.

The following types of **Federal Student Aid** are available:

Note: You must submit a **Free Application for Federal Student Aid** (FAFSA) each school year to determine eligibility for the following federal aid or any need-based institutional aid.

- \$ Grant Aid (Federal Pell Grant, Federal Supplemental Educational Opportunity Grant, Academic Competitive Grant, NOG)
- \$ William D. Ford Federal Direct Loan (Subsidized and Unsubsidized Loans)
(Loans require a Master Promissory Note on the web at www.studentloans.gov) plus Entrance Counseling completed on the web at www.studentloans.gov
- \$ Federal DL Parental Loans for Undergraduate Students (PLUS)
(Loans require a Master Promissory Note and application completed on the web at www.studentloans.gov)
- \$ Federal Work-Study jobs are available; ask the financial aid office for information on who to contact to apply for a job.

You may submit your FAFSA over the internet by logging on to: www.fafsa.ed.gov or by logging on NCC web sight www.nchristian.edu. You will need to list NCC as one of the schools to receive your information. The NCC

Federal School Code is: 012976.

NOTE: If you are relying on Federal Aid to help you pay your school bill, the FAFSA must be submitted once each school year and needs to be filled out for the 2013-2014 school year after the **2012** parental and student tax returns are completed. **It is best to file the FAFSA by May 1, 2013.**

You will receive a **Student Aid Report** (SAR) when you submit your FAFSA over the internet with an e-mail address; you will receive notification via e-mail.

Read and review the **Student Aid Report** (SAR) immediately. If you listed NCC as one of the schools to receive your SAR information it will be sent to the school electronically. If there are any errors on the SAR report, contact the NCC Financial Aid Office before you make the corrections. Once you have a correct SAR, we will be able to determine what type and how much financial aid you are eligible to receive.

If your **Student Aid Report** (SAR) indicates that you have been selected for verification, respond immediately to requests for additional information. You will be asked to fill out a Verification Worksheet and to provide signed copies of you and your parent's tax returns as well as W-2 forms.

You will receive an **Award Letter** from NCC as soon as all information has been received and reviewed by the Financial Aid Office. You will be asked to sign and return one copy of the award letter.

If you would like to apply for a **William D. Ford Federal Direct Loan**, fill in the loan amount desired on the Award Letter and return to the NCC Financial Aid Office for processing.

If your parent would like to apply for a **Parent Loan for Undergraduate Students** (PLUS) loan, contact the NCC Financial Aid Office for more information.
